

They Would Only Walk

As you may recall, we are the proud recipients of grants from the **National Endowment for the Arts and the Cullen Foundation** supporting a newlycommissioned piece composed by Mary Kouyoumdjian. In 2019-20, Mary expanded our students' sound worlds through experimentation on their instruments. She also interviewed students and parents, recording each family's' stories about their journeys from their countries of origins to Buffalo, NY.


Mary stitched together these interviews, creating a single spoken track featuring the many voices of BSW. She then composed music for students to perform with this track and for a string quintet from the Buffalo Chamber Players.

We were slated to perform the world premiere of *They Would Only Walk* in June 2020 but never to be stopped, we turned the preject into a professionally-recorded project in fall 2020. Staying well within health guidelines, we brought in small groups of students to Asbury Hall for a **momentous, 12-hour recording weekend!**
